## New sushi restaurant opens in Fairfield

**FAIRFIELD** — Fairfield-area residents in the mood for sushi and other Oriental cuisine have a new option at a familiar location.

Lords Sushi at 6679 Dixie Highway, recently opened in the location of the former Kobe Japanese Cuisine, which closed last year. Lords Sushi aims to provide residents with more exotic fare than is typically found in the area, said manager Sarah Yang.

Yang and her husband, chef James Park, hail from South Korea. Park handles the cooking while Yang handles the business side of the restaurant.

The restaurant offers everything from pork dumplings to spicy chicken dishes to sushi rolls.

One of their specialties is Korean cuisine. A chef at the restaurant had been a head chef at SuRa Korean Cuisine and at The Korea House, both in Mason, Yang said.

Korean cuisine is "really healthy because it has more vegetables than meat ... one (dish) has steamed rice on the bottom and vegetables on top, with a little bit of beef or chicken and fried egg on top," Yang said.

Lords Sushi makes a point of using fresh ingredients, said Yang. The idea is that the food nourishes not only the body, but also the mind, she said.

"I chose the name (Lords Sushi) with the nice Christian music ... we are honored to use the name. We pray every day that whoever comes will leave here feeling healed spiritually and physically," Yang said.
