

CITY OF FAIRFIELD  
LEGISLATION SUMMARY NO. 6-2016

Following is a summary of legislation adopted by the Fairfield City Council on March 28, 2016 and Fairfield Parks & Recreation Board on February 16, 2016. A complete text may be viewed at the following Fairfield locations: Fairfield Municipal Building (Room 138), Fairfield Lane Public Library, Fairfield YMCA, Fairfield Community Arts Center, and the Wildwood Manor House.

- Ord. 22-16 Professional Services Contract with the Fairfield Chamber of Commerce.
- Ord. 23-16 Community Reinvestment Area Agreement and a Community Reinvestment Area Compensation Agreement which will provide property tax incentives for Pacific Manufacturing Ohio, Inc. for the construction of an expansion to its manufacturing headquarters facility at 8935 Seward Road and declaring an emergency.
- Ord. 24-16 Agreement pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Section 715.02 with the Fairfield City School District Board of Education relative to traffic and water main improvements planned for three (3) new schools.
- Ord. 25-16 One (1) year contract with Greer Lime Company for the purchase of quick lime for use at the Water Treatment Plant with city option for two (2) additional one (1) year terms.
- Ord. 26-16 Contract with John R. Jurgensen for the 2016 Asphalt Paving and Resurfacing Project.
- Ord. 27-16 Establish salaries and hourly rates for certain salaried and hourly employees of the City of Fairfield, Ohio and to authorize and limit the numbers and types of certain employees, to repeal Ordinance No. 15-16 and all amendments thereto and declaring an emergency.
- Ord. 28-16 Establish salaries and hourly rates for certain Municipal Court employees of the City of Fairfield, Ohio and to authorize and limit the numbers and types of certain Municipal Court employees to repeal Ordinance No. 16-15 and all amendments thereto and declaring an emergency.
- Ord. 29-16 Establishing salaries for certain exempt and salaried employees of the City of Fairfield, Ohio, to repeal Ordinance No. 30-15 and all amendments thereto and declaring an emergency.
- Ord. 30-16 Appropriation Ordinance (Contractual Appropriations) – \$800,000 for 2016 Asphalt Paving and Resurfacing Project.
- Ord. 31-16 Appropriation Ordinance (Non-Contractual Appropriations) – \$66,272 for 2016 Parking Lot Maintenance Program; \$12,000 for purchase of replacement UV lamps for Wastewater Treatment Plant.
